REMINDER THAT THIS MEAL IS SERVED THROUGH A PROGRAM, WE ARE NOT A RESTAURANT

We need to remind some of you that this meal is served through a PROGRAM and we are NOT a restaurant. There are many rules and guidelines we are required to follow. Through the Code of State Regulations, we are monitored on operating practices.

Some of those rules are that you must have a reason for why a meal cannot be eaten inside the center and is taken out of the center and that reason has to be documented. Another is that unless you are authorized to take a meal out of the center, no food or milk can leave the building without prior approval. Another is that you are Contributing toward the cost of the meal and not "paying" for the meal. **The actual cost to produce the meal** is almost \$9, and you are asked to contribute toward the cost of the meal, and our suggested contribution is at least \$5. Thank you to those of you who contribute more!
